Dress Rehearsal:

- **Friday March 29, 2019** Please see the attached schedule
- Skaters should arrive with costumes on 10 minutes before scheduled time
- There will be a dressing room designated for each group. Signs will be posted for each dressing room. Please wait in the room for someone to come and get the group when it's your turn. **Please do not get ready in the stands.**
- The group will practice their number once or twice and then are free to go home
- Finale will not be practiced at dress rehearsal.
- We run on a very tight schedule and are not able to wait for late arrivals.

- **Sunday March 31, 2019 1pm and 6pm shows.** There are two performances approximately 1 ½ hours each with an intermission

- **Wednesday Precanskate, Canskate, Power Skaters are in the 1 pm show**
- **All Starskaters, Star Synchro teams, Adult and Alumni synchro teams are in both shows**
- Canskaters are to arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of their show times with their SKATES ON. They will be sitting in the stands for the whole show so please send them with coats, mitts and blankets. Parents are NOT allowed to sit with them. When they arrive they will be taken to their designated seats to sit with their group. At the end of the show they will be taken back to these seats for you to pick up from there. There will be supervision for the groups during the show.
- PREcanskaters have a dressing room assigned to them. One parent is allowed to accompany them to the dressing room if needed (parent required to pay for admission first). As they skate near the beginning of the show, these skaters can be picked up from the dressing room after their skate and can go and sit with their parents in the stands.
- Starskaters have dressing rooms assigned for changing costumes and have seating assigned to them for the show.
- There is an admission price for the show. Adults \$10.00. Seniors & \$ Children under 12 \$5.00, Family of 4 (2 Adults and 2 Children) \$25.00. We also have for sale programs, baked goods, raffles, flowers and a Sweet Legs Fundraising table
